

FAQ's:

What do I need to do/bring to participate?

If you are joining through the foster program as a new or existing volunteer, please make sure the [Canine Foster Orientation](#) is completed through your volunteer portal. This includes a quick orientation video about dog handling and a volunteer agreement to review and sign. Please bring an ID to confirm information.

When will the event take place?

The event will be held on Saturday, April 26th from 9am - 3pm.

Do I need to set up an appointment?

No, we are operating on a first come basis. We would recommend arriving early if you have a particular buddy in mind. Please check in with the front desk upon arrival.

Where can I take my buddy?

You can visit areas that are dog friendly such as trails, open markets, cafes, dog-friendly beaches, etc. Please make sure to avoid having your buddy off-leash and meeting animals in public. There will be certain limitations depending on your buddy based on age, mobility, and temperament. You can check in with our staff to be matched with a dog for your specific outing.

Can I participate if I have another dog?

Unfortunately, we require dog matches before our dogs are able to go on an outing or to foster but due to the expected high volume of participants, our staff will be unable to accommodate several matches during this event. However, you are welcome to sign up for an outing on another day when we have availability for a match!

What dogs will be part of the event?

Most of our dogs will be eligible to participate, excluding puppies and medical restricted animals.

Is it possible to extend the outing to a sleepover or foster?

Yes, most dogs will be available to foster if you decide to extend. Please check in with the foster team to prepare extra supplies for an overnight stay.
